## Human resources

## **Identification and Selection:**

## **Training:**

Conduct comprehensive training sessions covering poultry care, nutrition, disease management, and business planning.

## **Resource Provision:**



Distribute chicks, roosters, and necessary supplies to selected widows, ensuring they have the resources needed to start their egg farming businesses.



## **Monitoring and Support:**

Provide ongoing mentorship and support to widows, monitoring their progress, addressing challenges, and offering guidance as needed

## **Evaluation:**



Regularly assess the impact of the project on widows' livelihoods, community development, and overall well-being, making adjustments as necessary to maximize effectiveness

# Budget

The estimated budget for the project includes a well-protected cage (Size: 8' Width, 5' breadth and 6 feet height), expenses related to training sessions, procurement of chicks and roosters, supply of essential equipment and materials, transportation, and monitoring and evaluation activities.
